For injuries on or after 1/1/2013 an injured worker is entitled to a Supplemental Job Displacement Voucher if they are not offered a return to work for the employer in a regular, modified or alternate work position. This return to work determination must comply with the law with respect to ADA and FEHA, including conducting the Interactive Process with the employee. We will cover the basics with respect to understanding the employer's obligations for these return to work issues that arise in workers' compensation cases.
